Raised in London, Ontario, William McGrattan completed a Bachelor's of Engineering Science in Chemical Engineering from the University of Western Ontario in 1979, and was ordained in 1987.

Bishop McGrattan received a Licentiate in Fundamental Moral Theology in 1992 from the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome. From 1992 to 2009 Bishop McGrattan held various positions at St Peter's Seminary, London, including those of associate professor, rector, and dean of theology.

In November 2009, Pope Benedict XVI appointed him Auxiliary Bishop for the Archdiocese of Toronto.
